COMPLIANCE WITH EU REGULATIONS FOR FOOD CONTACT PLASTICS – FOOD CONTACT STATEMENT

POLISAN HELLAS S.A declares that all PolIPET preform types are manufactured by using only the PolIPET resin grades: PolIPET 76W, PolIPET 80GP, PolIPET84SD and PolIPET 84F which are in compliance with the requirements of the following EU regulations:

- EC Regulation 1935/2004 (general requirements, article 3) for all materials and articles intended to come into contact with food
- EU Regulation 10/2011 and all its amendments, on plastic materials and articles to come into contact with food
- EC Regulation 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practices for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food
- EC Directive 94/62 (article 11) and its amendments on packaging and packaging waste

Detailed info regarding PolIPET resin grades compliance and other regulatory information included in the **POLISAN HELLAS Declaration of Compliance PolIPET resins document**.

Colorants for specific colored preforms types production are liquid master batches, that may be lawfully used as a component of plastic articles that will contact food. All colorant constituents are in compliance with the requirements and specifications of the Council of Europe Resolution AP(89) 1 "On the use of colorants in plastic materials coming into contact with food" and in compliance with the legislation in place in the European Union (EU) on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food (as mentioned above).

As PET resin & preforms must be further processed in order to produce final articles, compliance with the migration and other requirements can only be demonstrated by tests carried out on the final article. *So, it is the responsibility of both the manufacturers of finished articles and the industrial packers to make sure that these articles in their actual use are in compliance with imposed specific and overall migration requirements*
